- ✓ Evidence of strong technology and computer skills since using Zoom and PC-Biz is necessary.
- ✓ Past service to the presbytery and its congregations.
- ✓ Commitment to continued service to the presbytery and its congregations following GA.
- ✓ Endorsement by candidate's pastor and session.
- ✓ Diversity and geographic distribution concerns within the presbytery.
- ✓ Preference will be given to applicants from different congregations in successive General Assemblies.
- ✓ Preference will be given to the most recent alternates should they be willing and available to serve.
